



A true healing miracle by faith in Jesus

(Mark 5:25-34.)

Desperate people come up with desperate ideas

This is shown clearly in this story of a desperate woman, and her being cured, when someone was around who did miracles. His name was Jesus - a 'Teacher' or 'Rabbi' who, so she had heard, performed real miracles.

If you had/have a bleeding ulcer or some sort of infection that many doctors **could not** fix...but had taken all your money - would you feel desperate too? Yes indeed, you would, and it is the same for desperate people who need help.

The woman in the story, was such a person. She had suffered for many years and – the Bible story says, "...was actually worse." After spending all her money on doctors ... and being 'this-sick' made her 'unclean' for religious practices, therefore she could not go to the Synagogue: Her local area Jewish temple.



Someone must have told her, remember or imagine back then: NO mobile phones, NO radio or TV or newspapers, just people telling each other the latest news, or gossip.

Well the news of a miracle worker like this Jesus, must have thrilled this poor woman. She figured (believed or 'worked-it-out') that if she could just push through the crowd and touch His garment, she would be healed. **So that is what she did. She had faith!**

She elbowed her way close to Jesus, and touched His clothes! Instantly she felt herself healed! But Jesus knew about it too.



Jesus stopped walking, turned around and said: "Who touched me?" His disciples said: "Master, people crowd around you,

and you ask, 'Who touched me?'



Jesus said He felt power go from him, so he kept asking. (Jesus had the power within Him, from His Father, God) The poor, now healed woman came, trembling to Jesus and said that she had touched him and she felt healed.

Jesus said to her: "Woman, your faith has made you whole. Now go in peace." Her faith in Jesus, had made her whole.



No anger or problem for Jesus, and also He went out of His way to raise another little girl from being dead →→→ back to life. (See Story: 'Jairus's Daughter was dead.')

What a Saviour!

"Do miracles still happen today?"

Well not the same way as in this story but they definitely do still happen. "How?" Well: "The angel of the Lord encamps around them that fear Him and He delivers them." (From the 'Book of Songs' many of these songs were written by King David are recorded – in words - in the Bible called 'Psalms' chapter 34 v 7)

Today there are hospitals and medical centres everywhere - but more so in Christian countries. I think it is true to say that Christian countries lead the world in treating sickness because care and compassion came from Jesus and Christians follow that way.
